- Morris County Vocational School uses a computerized point of sale system in the cafeteria.
- This system allows for account purchase of meals.
- Parents can make payments online allowing them to pay in advance for purchases.
- All students will be issued a Personal Identification Number (PIN) which corresponds to their food service account, which should be kept confidential.
- Graduating seniors with remaining balances less than \$20.00 at the end of the school year will not be refunded.

- The internet convenience fee is a percentage for credit cards and a flat fee for ACH transaction
